- Meal delivery from <u>Mom's Meals</u> after hospital discharge for members with congestive heart failure (on some plans)
- Acupuncture to manage pain for metro Classic plan members with qualifying diagnoses

"We added these enhancements to improve our members' experience and support their whole health in meaningful ways," said Ghita Worcester, Senior Vice President of Public Affairs and Chief Marketing Officer. "Over the years, members requested these supplemental benefits, and we listened and responded as a member-centered organization."

UCare offers a robust portfolio of plans for people at every stage of their Medicare journey. Members will have minimal to no premium increases on most UCare Medicare plans in 2020. They will continue to have access to 96% of providers, including Mayo, in all plans with the exception of partner plans with Essentia Health, and Fairview and North Memorial Health.
