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UCare announces sweeping premium cuts across its 2024 Medicare portfolio

Medicare Part B premium giveback benefit added to \$0 PPO plan

MINNEAPOLIS, Oct. 2, 2023 — Affordability and convenience define <u>UCare's Medicare Advantage Plan</u> enhancements in 2024. As the Medicare shopping season begins, UCare has reduced premiums across its Medicare portfolio by an average of \$14/month, added a \$39/month Medicare Part B premium giveback and expanded service area to UCare Your Choice plans, and increased the network-free flexible allowance for dental care, eyewear and hearing aids.

<u>UCare's</u> robust portfolio includes a full slate of individual Medicare Advantage and Medicare Supplement plans designed to meet Medicare enrollees where they are in their health journey. The plans have an extensive provider network with 96% of providers in Minnesota, including large care systems Allina Health, CentraCare, Essentia Health, M Health Fairview and others.*

In 2024, UCare Your Choice plans – popular among recent retirees and those new to Medicare – will expand to serve more Minnesotans, with the \$0 plan being available statewide and the \$56 metro-area Plus plan expanding north. The \$0 plan flexible benefit allowance (pre-loaded on a card) will increase from \$900 to \$1,200 a year to pay for dental care, eyewear/contacts and hearing aids from any provider. The Plus plan premium is being reduced from \$75 to \$56, with its yearly flexible benefit allowance increasing from \$1,800 to \$2,000. With no network limitations, Medicare members can shop for these "extras" where they prefer, especially when traveling or escaping winter as "snowbirds".

"We appreciate the value our Medicare members place on affordability, choice and a broad network of providers during their retirement. That's why we focused on reducing costs and enhancing benefits that support our members' whole health including their mental, dental and preventive health," said Jay Sivasailam, Executive Vice President and Chief Growth Officer. "We also elevated our members' experience by combining all supplemental benefits into one easy card."

Every year UCare evaluates opportunities to enrich coverage and provide more value for its Medicare members. For 2024, the following changes offer significant value:

- Wide-ranging premium cuts from \$10 \$24 month across the entire Medicare Advantage portfolio
- Reduced prescription drug costs with \$0 copay on tier 1 (preferred generics) drugs for all plans and a \$0 Part D drug deductible on UCare Your Choice and Your Choice Plus plans
- \$0 copays for outpatient mental health services and substance use disorder services on all plans
- One card solution for supplemental benefits such as over-the-counter (OTC) medicine and supplies, food discounts and flexible spending allowance
- Increased Medicare Part B premium giveback in the Value Plus (MA-only plan) from \$30/month to \$50/month
- Inflation Reduction Act \$35/month insulin and no-cost Medicare Part D vaccines such as the hepatitis, RSV, shingles, tetanus and travel vaccines
