Updated Requirements Grids

MSC+/MSHO and Connect/Connect + Medicare effective 11/1/2023

UCare has updated Requirements Grids for all products due to the end of the Public Health Emergency and the return to in-person assessments. All grids now describe when in-person is required and when televideo or phone assessments are permitted. We will continue to review the requirements from DHS and CMS but these draft grids have the current guidance as of today. See attached In-Person Job Aids and Decision Trees for guidance. Thank you for your patience while we navigate ongoing changes.
