UCare Medicare Supplement (Medigap) Plans

UCare offers three Medicare Supplement Plans for Medicare-eligible individuals throughout Minnesota.

- UCare Basic Medicare Supplement
- UCare Extended Basic Medicare Supplement
- UCare \$20/\$50 Copay Medicare Supplement

Members in these plans may seek care from any provider who accepts Medicare assignment for patients. The Medicare Supplement plans do not include prescription drug coverage. Enrollees must purchase a separate Part D plan. UCare currently does not offer a stand-alone Part D plan.

Enrollment:

Open enrollment begins 6 months following the time the senior receives Part B coverage, after this time they are subject to medical underwriting.

ID Cards:

Following is an example of what the UCare Medicare Supplement ID card looks like. New in 2022 is the fitness benefit, One Pass.



Medicare Supplement Eligibility, Benefits, Claims and Other Questions:

Providers should call 1-800-221-6930 and follow the prompts for information on eligibility, benefits, claims and more for the Medicare Supplement plans.

Claim Submissions:

Claims for members in one of the UCare Medicare Supplement plans should be submitted directly to Medicare. Medicare Supplement claims that are paid by UCare will be processed once a week and sent on Thursdays.
