UCare Medicare Supplement (Medigap) Plans

UCare offers three Medicare Supplement Plans for Medicare-eligible individuals throughout Minnesota.

- UCare Basic Medicare Supplement
- UCare Extended Basic Medicare Supplement
- UCare \$20/\$50 Copay Medicare Supplement

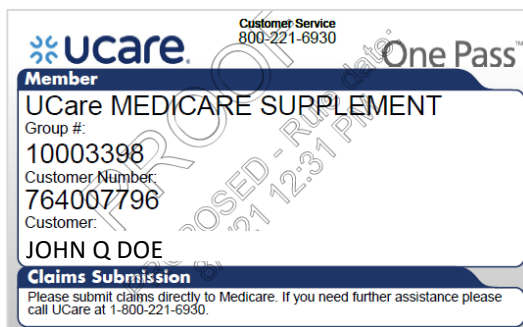
Members in these plans may seek care from any provider who accepts Medicare assignment for patients. The Medicare Supplement plans do not include prescription drug coverage. Enrollees must purchase a separate Part D plan. UCare currently does not offer a stand-alone Part D plan.

Enrollment

Open enrollment begins six months following the time the senior receives Part B coverage, after this time they are subject to medical underwriting.

Claims for members in one of UCare's Medicare Supplement plans should be submitted directly to Medicare. Medicare Supplement claims that are paid by UCare will be processed once a week.
