## Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) Provider Relief Fund Distribution Update

Earlier this month, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced that it is extending the Medicaid and CHIP Provider Relief Fund distribution provider application deadline to apply to **Sept. 13, 2020** [DEADLINE UPDATED]. The information was shared in an announcement that a second round of funding was being distributed to high-impact COVID-19 area hospitals.

On June 9, HHS opened the application period and plans to distribute approximately \$15 billion to eligible providers that participate in state Medicaid and CHIP programs who had not yet received a payment from the \$50 billion General Distribution. Since that announcement, HHS has hosted webinars for providers and provider organizations to answer questions and assist those eligible through the application process.
