License Requirements for Customized Living Services Will Change August 1

Effective August 1, 2021, Minnesota's license requirement for customized living services (CLS) will change. All registered housing establishments with services will need to have an assisted living facility license to provide assisted living services, according to Minnesota Statutes.

This applies to the following Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) waiver programs managed by UCare:

• Elderly Waiver (EW) – UCare's Minnesota Senior Health Options (MSHO) and UCare Minnesota Senior Care Plus (MSC+)
