Early Intensive Developmental and Behavioral Intervention (EIDBI) Claim Payment Reminder

UCare follows Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) guidelines for the rendering and billing of EIDBI services. A practitioner who actually provides the member-facing service must bill the service as the rendering provider. When a Qualified Supervising Professional (QSP) is required to supervise an EIDBI service, the QSP information must be submitted in addition to the rendering provider information, or the claim will be denied.

When submitting claims for EIDBI services, the following guidelines should be followed:

- Only list a QSP provider as the rendering provider if they personally performed the service. Otherwise, list the QSP as the person who is supervising the rendering provider, as well as the rendering provider.
- It is not necessary to submit both the UB (EIDBI) and UA (mental health) modifier. When submitting EIDBI services, only the UB modifier should be submitted.

When a Level I, II or III technician is the provider of service, they should be identified as the rendering provider. This practitioner type does not require credentialing and can be added to our system through the UCare Non-Credentialed Practitioner Add Form (on the Manage Your Information web page).
